We have a goal of acquiring 13,402 contributions and 79,395 minutes of collaborative design. 13,402 is the estimated number of students we will have in our district by 2025. The members of our Strategic Plan Core Planning Team met on October 25-27, for their initial planning meeting. This group is made up of district staff, external educational partners, civic leaders, corporate executives, non-profit organizers, members of the faith community, philanthropists, and most importantly, students. 






# District Calendar Survey
